A bylaw to amend Bylaw No 3-92, known as Village of Glaslyn bylaw to license and regulate the running of dogs at large.

The Council for the Village of Glaslyn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 3-92 as follows:

- 1. SECTION 7, is amended as follows:
 - a. A violator of this bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to a penalty of:

i.	First offence	\$125.00
ii.	Second offence	\$250.00
iii.	Third and subsequent offences	\$375.00
