WATER AND SEWER RATES BYLAW – BYLAW 2-16

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF GLASLYN TO FIX THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR CONSUMPTION OF MUNICIPAL WATER AND THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SEWER

The Council for the Village of Glaslyn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known and may be cited as *“The Water and Sewer Rates Bylaw”*.
2. Prior to having any water service turned on, the water consumer shall pay to the Village of Glaslyn a meter deposit in the amount set out in Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of this bylaw. The said meter deposit shall be held in trust until such time as the services are terminated. Upon termination of services, the deposit shall be applied to the final billing.
3. The charges to be paid by the water consumer whose water service has been turned on shall be those set out in Schedule “B” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
4. Consumers who own or occupy premises drained or that are, by Bylaw, required to be drained into the sewer shall pay for such services the charges set out in Schedule “C” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
5. Consumers wishing to obtain bulk water from the Village of Glaslyn water vending machine shall be able to purchase bulk water at the rates set in accordance with Schedule “D” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
6. Consumers will be assessed an environmental surcharge for the solid waste management and recycling program set out in Schedule “E” attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
7. Accounts for water and/or sewer service as established by Sections 3 and 4 shall cover a period of three successive months, and shall be rendered on or before the fifteenth (15) of the month next following such period. Accounts are considered due and shall be paid by consumers on or before the due date which is noted on the invoice as received by the consumer. If an account is not paid on or before the due date, the water service may be shut off until such time as payment has been received or acceptable payment arrangements have been made.
8. Terminated utility accounts with outstanding balances may be added to the tax roll with respect to the parcel to which the utility services were provided.

9. Bylaw No. _____ and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
10. These rates and charges contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Saskatchewan Municipal Board.
